



Program Specialist (Senior Compliance Specialist) position (GS-14) in Washington, DC or Chicago, IL through August 3, 2022.

HUD's Office of Recapitalization is seeking a Recapitalization Program Specialist (Senior Compliance Specialist) (GS-14) within its Program Administration Office (Policy Division) to be based in either Washington, DC or Chicago, IL. This role will focus specifically on leading coordination with the HUD Office of Inspector General officials and other Federal officials on program audits and independently conducting remote and on-site monitoring for program compliance of affordable housing transactions under the Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) program, a high-profile initiative to significantly improve and preserve deeply affordable housing across the country. Duties may include establishing, tracking and ensuring compliance with corrective action plans, developing standard operating procedures and policy recommendations related to the enforcement of corrective action plans for HUD Multifamily assets or public housing properties undergoing RAD conversions, working closely with high level officials to resolve complex and sensitive issues, conducting program quality control assessments, and providing technical support to various internal and external stakeholders. Applicants with backgrounds in Federal government program compliance or with extensive experience in monitoring Federal or local programs are encouraged to apply. Knowledge of affordable housing preservation finance is a plus.
