

## **HAND Children's Essay Contest**

"Community Heroes"

The Housing Association of Nonprofit Developers (HAND) invites the students residing in your communities to participate in our Children's Essay Contest! This year we are hosting an essay competition themed *Community Heroes*. HAND encourages you to use this contest as an opportunity to engage your youth in sharing their perspectives. The essay aims to empower students, foster confidence, amplify their voices, and allow them to pen their own stories of community heroism. It's a wonderful opportunity for young writers to shine a light on the unsung heroes in their neighborhoods.

The contest is open to children who attend elementary school (ages 6-12) and reside in properties owned or operated by HAND members. The community program staff should host its own contest and mail the top entry from each property to: Courtney Battle, HAND, 1330 New Hampshire Avenue, NW, Suite 124, Washington, DC 20036. Completed submissions MUST abide by the following Contest Guidelines to be eligible for the Grand Prize and Runners-Up awards.

A \$500 cash prize will be awarded to the winner of the contest at the **33**<sup>rd</sup> **Annual HAND Honors**, taking place on June 13, 2024 from 6pm - 9pm at The Kennedy Center. The runners-up will each receive a \$30 gift card and a certificate of participation.

## **CONTEST GUIDELINES**

## **CONTENT**

- ◆ For this year's essay contest, we're looking for inspiring stories about real-life community heroes. Children are encouraged to choose someone in their community who they have a personal connection with, such as a family member, friend, tutor, teacher, coach, counselor, etc. Remember, the person should not be fictional or someone the child doesn't have a personal relationship with. Let's celebrate the amazing individuals who make a difference in our communities through the power of storytelling!
- ◆ In 250 words or less, entries must include interpretations of the contest theme, "Community Heroes," responding to one of the following questions:
  - Who is a hero in your community? Write about someone who inspires you and explain why they deserve recognition. Share their accomplishments and the reasons behind their inspiring qualities.
  - Imagine you are a reporter and interview a person who you believe is a community hero. Discover their story and the difference they have made.

- Are you a hero in your community? Share a story about a time you helped someone in your community or describe an idea you have to improve your neighborhood or help others.
- ◆ Entries should be recorded on the pages at the end of this document, typewritten or handwritten in blue or black ink.

## **REGISTRATION & SUBMISSION**

- ◆ The contest is open to children who attend elementary school (ages 6-12) and who reside in properties owned or operated by HAND members.
- ◆ Community program staff should mail the <u>top entry</u> to: Courtney Battle, HAND, 1330 New Hampshire Avenue, NW, Suite 124, Washington, DC 20036. <u>The HAND team will only accept ONE entry from each HAND member organization.</u>
- ♦ All submissions should include a completed entry form stapled to the back of the essay.
- ◆ All essays must be original work.

#### **DEADLINE**

Deadline for submission of entries is **March 8th, 2024 at 5:00 PM** (must be postmarked by March 8th). **Late entries will not be accepted**.

## **AWARDS**

- ◆ Grand Prize: A \$500 cash prize will be awarded to the winner of the contest. We request the winner attend the 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual HAND Honors taking place in June 2024.
- ♦ Runners-Up: Ten runners-up will each receive a \$30 gift card and a certificate of participation.

## **HOW ARE THE ESSAYS JUDGED?**

Entries are judged on the author's ability to write an essay illustrating the "Community Heroes" contest theme. Specifically, the panel of judges will consider:

- ◆ Interpretation of the theme, ""Community Heroes."
- ◆ Originality Written copy is the original creation of the student.
- ◆ Overall writing ability Essay shows a degree of creativity and skill for its age group.
