"I Am"

The Housing Association of Nonprofit Developers (HAND) invites the students residing in your communities to participate in our Children's Essay Contest! This year we are hosting an essay competition themed *I Am*. HAND encourages you to use this contest as an opportunity to engage your youth in sharing their perspectives on their experiences, interests, talents, hopes and dreams. This essay is intended to help students to build confidence, use their voice, and pen their own stories.

The contest is open to children who attend elementary school (ages 6-12) and reside in properties owned or operated by HAND members. **The community program staff should host its own contest and mail the top entry from each property to:** Courtney Battle, HAND, 1330 New Hampshire Avenue, NW, Suite 124, Washington, DC 20036. Completed submissions **MUST abide by the following Contest Guidelines to be eligible for the Grand Prize and Runners-Up awards.**

A \$500 cash prize will be awarded to the winner of the contest at the **32nd Annual HAND Honors**, taking place in June 2023. The runners-up will each receive a \$30 gift card and a certificate of participation.

CONTEST GUIDELINES

CONTENT

- ◆ Essays should reflect this year's theme, "*I Am*."
- ◆ In 250 words or less, entries must include interpretations of the contest theme, responding to one of the following questions:
 - Tell us about yourself. What makes you unique? What is your superpower? How can you use your talents to make a difference in your community?
 - What is your greatest accomplishment and why? How did it make you feel? What steps did you take to reach this achievement?
 - Share your hopes and dreams. What ambitions do you have? How do you plan to make your dreams a reality?
- ◆ Entries should be recorded on the pages at the end of this document, typewritten or handwritten in blue or black ink.

REGISTRATION & SUBMISSION

- ◆ The contest is open to children who attend elementary school (ages 6-12) and who reside in properties owned or operated by HAND members.
- ◆ Community program staff should mail the **top entry** to: Courtney Battle, HAND, 1330 New

Hampshire Avenue, NW, Suite 124, Washington, DC 20036. **The HAND team will only accept ONE entry from each HAND member organization.**

- ◆ All submissions should include a completed entry form stapled to the back of the essay.
- ◆ All essays must be original work.

DEADLINE

Deadline for submission of entries is **April 14th, 2023 at 5:00 PM** (must be postmarked by April 14th). **Late entries will not be accepted.**

AWARDS

- ◆ Grand Prize: A \$500 cash prize will be awarded to the winner of the contest. **We request he or she attend the 32nd Annual HAND Honors taking place in June 2023.**
- ◆ Runners-Up: Ten runners-up will each receive a \$30 gift card and a certificate of participation.

HOW ARE THE ESSAYS JUDGED?

Entries are judged on the author's ability to write an essay illustrating the "I Am" contest theme. Specifically, the panel of judges will consider:

- ◆ Interpretation of the theme, "I Am."
- ◆ Originality – Written copy is the original creation of student.
- ◆ Overall writing ability – Essay shows a degree of creativity and skill for its age group.
