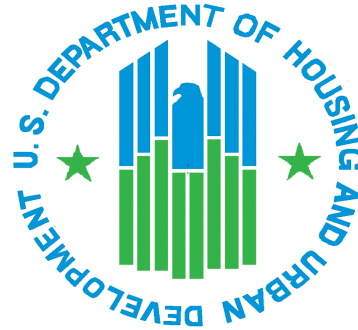


Career Opportunities with HUD
