Member Duties : The VISTA member will develop a standardized process for grant applications and procedures including tracking methods for deadlines and time management, integrating racial equity into programs, policies, and general practices, and implementing resident surveys to assess resident satisfaction while identifying gaps in services. In addition, the VISTA will strengthen the communication strategies with AHDC residents in order to improve engagement, showcase volunteer opportunities, and promote available resources and services provided by the organization. The VISTA member will also aid in the research and development of a financial literacy program in collaboration with community partnerships as part of the Ready-Stable-Own (RSO) initiative.
